



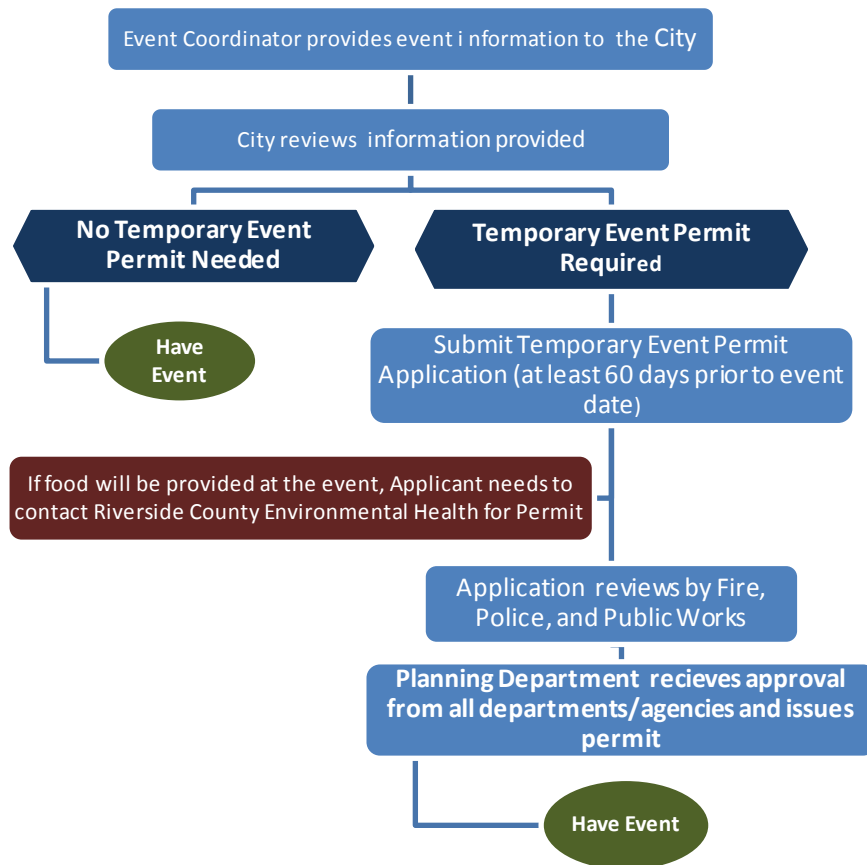
Temporary Event Permit Information

Temporary events are typically one-time events of short duration (including annual or recurring events). Examples include fairs; carnivals; rodeos; shows; walking, running, and/or bicycling events and races; parades, and tent revival meetings. Some events are explicitly exempted from the requirement of a Temporary Event Permit, but some events not listed may also be exempted. To determine whether your event is exempted, please review the list of exempted events in Section 5.11.C of the Zoning Code that is attached to this sheet. If your event is not listed, please notify the City of the proposed event with the information requested below. You may send the information to the Planning Department via email at planning@eastvaleca.gov or mail it to City Hall at 12363 Limonite Avenue, Suite 910, Eastvale, CA 91752.

Information needed to determine if a Temporary Event Permit is required

- Event address/location
- Description of the event, including date(s) of the events, hours of operation, estimated daily attendance, available on-site parking spaces, etc.
- Will the event take place entirely or partially on a public road or right-of-way?
- Will the event have the potential to exceed the capacity of onsite parking?
- Will the event require special traffic controls?
- Will a fee or donation be required for admission?
