- MOTOR PARTS OR MOTOR OIL • POOL CHEMICALS • COMMERCIAL OR REMODELING WASTE
- TRANSMISSION/BRAKE FLUIDS • WEED KILLERS/HERBICIDES • BLEACH/TUB & TILE CLEANER
- FERTILIZERS • PESTICIDES & RODENT POISONS • ANTI-FREEZE • SOLVENTS/GASOLINE • ENGINES

Proof of Eastvale residency is required. Please bring a photo ID along with your Waste Management bill to the event. Residents with trailers and/or enclosed storage trucks will be directed to the landfill. Please note that company vehicles will be turned away.



Eastvale residents with curbside cart service may request two (2) times in a calendar year, the free pick up of six (6) household bulky items. Additional bulky item pick ups are available at a nominal cost. Bulky items include: Sofas, washers, dryers, refrigerators, mattresses, water heaters, lawn furniture, televisions, computer monitors, etc.

*Items not included in this program are large items such as car bodies, jacuzzi tubs, spas or construction and demolition waste, tires, hazardous waste or any other items that cannot be handled by two persons.*

*Please note, items are collected by a different Waste Management truck, not your regular service truck.*


