A Self-Haul Permit is required in lieu of making arrangement for solid waste collection through the City's contracted waste collection provider. The issuance of a self-haul permit requires approval from the Community Safety Director or his/her designee and full payment of permit fees. The requirements for the issuance and continuance of the self- haul permit include but are not limited to the following:

Self-Haul Permit Issuance Requirements (Approved by Resolution 22-08-A)

An application for self-haul permit accompanied with a permit fee as follows:

(Permit fee is non-refundable and will not be prorated other than outlined above)

- 1. Vehicle requirements for hauling solid waste:
 - a. Vehicle must be operational and meet all applicable Vehicle Code Standards.
 - b. Hauling capacity of a minimum of 32 gallons of Gray Container Waste, Non-Organic Recyclables, and Organic Waste.
 - c. Ability to haul waste materials in a safe, sanitary manner so that no material will spill, leak, drip, blow scatter or fall from vehicle.
 - d. For vehicles that are not fully enclosed, applicant must produce a tarp or other material that will be used to completely secure materials being self-hauled.
- 2. Evidence of valid vehicle registration.
- 3. Evidence of applicant ownership of vehicle or written agreement to use vehicle for the hauling.
- 4. A valid California driver's license and proof of automobile insurance.
- 5. Provide proof of available container on property for storage of solid waste, recyclables and compostable.
- 6. Applicant must be in good standing with City of Eastvale and city contracted refuse collection provider for all costs of refuse collection services previously provided.
- 7. Commercial applicants must have an active business license.

Self-Haul Permit General Requirements/ Provisions

- 1. Self-haul permits shall be good for one calendar year and shall expire on December 31st each year. Permit may be renewed annually.
- 2. Permittee is responsible to notify the City of any change in vehicle used for self- hauling solid waste, and is responsible to provide current license, insurance, and registration documents on file with the City for the duration of the permit. No notification will be provided by the city. Failure to provide updated/current document will result in the revocation of the self-haul permit.
- 3. Permittee must separate and bag solid waste, recyclables, and organic waste.
- 4. Permittee must dispose of solid waste weekly at any licensed or permitted landfill or disposal facility and provide proof to the city monthly. Applicant shall procure and retain weekly receipts for disposal of all solid waste/recyclables/green waste which shall be submitted to the City on a quarterly basis as proof of disposal.
- 5. Permittee must adhere to SB 1383 recordkeeping requirements.
- 6. Permittee will be required to certify that no waste was generated during any period of vacation or vacancy. Certification as to periods of vacancy will be made by applicant on quarterly reporting documents. Disposal receipts may not be required during times of vacation or vacancy. There will be no refund of permit fees for periods of vacation/vacancy.
- 7. Permittee is liable for any damages and cleanup costs resulting from any solid waste, recycling, or green waste spilling, leaking, dripping, blowing scattering, or falling during the course of self-hauling activities.
- 8. The permit shall be subject to revocation if the permittee violates any provision of Eastvale's Municipal Code Chapter 16.05
