

MILITARY BANNER APPLICATION

How do I participate?

The Military Banner Program recognizes and honors Eastvale residents and immediate family members (spouse, parent, legal guardian, grandparent, child or siblings) that are serving on active duty in the United States Armed Forces. For the purpose of this program, "Active Duty" is defined as 12 months of continuous service.

To participate in the program, fill out the attached application and include a copy of your driver's license and a current utility bill showing an Eastvale address. Quantity is limited to one (1) banner per service person, installed for the length of service per annual renewal.

Banner Creation

Once the application is approved, the City will create and install the banner along Archibald Avenue on the closest installation date. Banners are installed twice per year - in May and November.

Installation and removal of the banners are at the City's discretion.

Banners will be returned to the applicant upon removal if available.

Sample Banner

Banners can be created with the serviceperson's without. portrait or Portraits should be of serviceperson uniform and applicants responsible for are supplying the picture. Each portrait will scanned to meet the 1MB size requirements. If emailing the portrait, please ensure the file is a JPG or PNG format. **Photos** will not be returned.
