Eastvale Receives Official Support from the State of California Regarding Independent ZIP Code Advocacy Efforts

EASTVALE, CA: On June 13, 2023, Senator Richard Roth's Senate Joint Resolution (SJR) 3 passed both houses of the State Legislature and made its way to Governor Gavin Newsom's desk. This bill, co-sponsored with the support of Assemblymembers Sabrina Cervantes and Bill Essayli, urges Congress and the President to give the City of Eastvale its own ZIP code.

The City of Eastvale is proud to announce that Governor Gavin Newsom signed SJR 3 on June 20, 2023, symbolizing the State of California's official support of Eastvale's independent ZIP code advocacy efforts.

Shortly after, Mayor Todd Rigby, Mayor Pro Tem Christian Dinco, and members of the City team headed to Washington D.C. to speak with members of Congress regarding the issue. Eastvale's residents and business face extensive real-world issues because the city's ZIP codes do not match its municipal boundaries. Issues discussed include emergency management, public safety, business attraction, mail delivery, and insurance policies. The City's hope is that Congress and the President would consider the State of California's support and recent discussions and would allow Eastvale to receive its own ZIP code.
