Carbon Monoxide Alarm Verification

The California Residential Code requires the installation of carbon monoxide detectors in existing dwellings when alterations, repairs or additions with a valuation exceeding \$1000.00 are made.

These alarms must be installed in the immediate vicinity of the bedrooms <u>and</u> on each level of the residence. These alarms must be installed in accordance with the alarm manufacturer's installation instructions. Battery-only type alarms must be equipped with a 10-year battery and have a silence feature.

This is a voluntary self-certification verification procedure. If you prefer to have a building inspector perform the verification, it must be performed at the time of the final inspection for your project. You must also arrange to have an adult present at the time of the inspection and provide access to the alarms.
