CITY COUNCIL COMMISSIONS

Each standing board, commission, or committee consists of five members. Other boards, commissions or committees could have more or less members.

Unless stated otherwise below, each Council Member appoints one member to serve concurrently with his/her term of office. All appointments are ratified by the full Council. Members serve at the pleasure of the Council and can be removed by a simple majority of the Council, without cause.

PLANNING COMMISSION*

The Planning Commission is a five-member commission composed of residents appointed by the City Council. The Commission advises the City Council on land use and development issues, taking input and making recommendations on the General Plan, zoning ordinance, design standards, and related matters. The Commission meets on the 3rd Wednesday of each month at 6:00PM. Commissioners receive a \$50 stipend per meeting.

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMISSION*

The Public Safety Commission is a five-member commission. The Commission was created to utilize the rich talent pool of experienced citizens to provide recommendations on Public Safety issues such as Traffic issues, Neighborhood Watch, Emergency Preparedness, and Crime Prevention. These issues affect the quality of life in Eastvale. The Public Safety Commission functions as an advisory board to the City Council. The Commission meets on the 4th Tuesday of each month at 6:00PM. Commissioners receive a \$50 stipend per meeting.

** California Government Code Section 87200 states that an elected or appointed official and candidates must complete a Statement of Economic Interests (Form 700). Members must fully disclose their investments, interests in real property, business positions, and income (including loans, gifts, and travel payments). Any information listed on the Form 700 and this application is a matter of public record and will be disclosed upon request.*

Under existing California law, a member of a board or commission may not make, participate in making, or attempt to influence a governmental decision if it is reasonably foreseeable that the decision could have a material financial effect on that member, the member's immediate family, or any of his or her financial interests. There is also a special category of conflicts of interest which strictly forbids members and/or their employers from having financial interests in city contracts. Careful consideration should be given to this issue and applicants are encouraged to contact the City Clerk's Office if they have any questions.
