BACKGROUND:

At the City Council Meeting of October 24, 2013, City Council Member Kelly Howell announced her resignation from the City Council effective November 30, 2013. Council member Howell was elected to the City's first election effective October 1, 2010. Her term expires in November 2014.

On December 11, 2013, the City Council took action to fill the vacancy through appointment as authorized under state law and directed staff to establish the appointment process. Staff opened the application period on December 12, 2013 and closed the application process on December 26, 2013 at noon. The City Council chose to hold interviews with each of the candidates on January 6, 2014.

If the vacant Council seat is not filled by appointment by January 28, 2014, the City will be required to call a special election on April 8, 2014. The County of Riverside Registrar of Voters has estimated the cost to the City between \$60,000 -\$66,000.

The following process has been recommended by staff to insure a fair and open process.

Candidates will be asked to sit in the library until such time as the City Council calls for them to be interviewed. Candidates will not be allowed to hear each other's comments or the questions asked by the City Council. All candidates' names will be placed in a "hat" and a name will be selected randomly by the Mayor.

Each candidate will begin with a two minute opening statement. A staff member will have a timer and will not allow individuals to go past the two minute mark.

The Council will have a set list of questions to ask each candidate. All candidates will be asked the same initial questions. The candidates will have two minutes to respond to each question. After the prepared questions have been asked and answered, the Council will have a maximum of five minutes for follow up questions.

This will conclude the candidate interviews. All candidates will then be invited to sit in the audience.

After the interviews are completed the City Council deliberations, discussions and appointment of the successful candidate to fill the vacant seat will be in open session.

ALTERNATIVES:

The City Council has a number of options to fill the vacant Council seat. State law does not dictate the process of appointment; only that the process must be done in open session. Other options may include: 1) no interviews of candidates, select based on written application, 2) Council members ask questions of the candidate based on the application, 3) time limits on questions and responses can be changed or eliminated, 4) or any combination of the above or other interviewing technique the City Council may choose.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Should the City Council appoint a candidate to fill the vacant Council seat, there is no additional cost to this process. If the Council is unable to appoint by January 28, 2014, the seat will automatically be decided during a special election on April 8, 2014 at an estimated cost of \$60,000-\$66,000.

BACKGROUND AND QUALIFICATIONS (ATTACH RESUMÉ IF DESIRED): I have dedicated my life to public service. In my professional career, I have worked for the United States Department of Justice and am currently employed as an attorney for the United States Department of Homeland Security. In this capacity, I enforce federal laws and regulations and advise officers and agents in investigations as well as on the apprehension and detention of criminal violators. Governance of a city requires such an understanding of the law as well as of the interplay between state and local law. It also requires consideration of policy implications. In this regard, I have undergraduate degrees from the University of California, Los Angeles, in political science and sociology with a minor in public policy. Through my professional involvements and extensive community service, I have consistently worked towards the betterment of my city, state, and country, and in the interest of public safety.

WHAT DO YOU FEEL ARE THE MOST IMPORTANT ISSUES FACING THE CITY OF EASTVALE?:

Eastvale's most significant issues are closely linked to its rapid expansion prior to incorporation. For most of its history, the area was primarily comprised of dairy and agricultural farms. Its roads were suited for those purposes. However, between the years 2000 and 2010, Eastvale, then an unincorporated part of Riverside County, experienced approximately 793% growth. Eastvale now finds itself with a road system and school system inadequate to support its growth and a public service system that will also need to expand. Roads like Schleisman, Harrison, and Sumner experience heavy traffic. Though Eastvale is 90-95% developed, a location has not been set for the seventh planned elementary school in the area. According to the Corona Norco Unified School District, Eleanor Roosevelt High School will reach its maximum capacity within five years. In the meantime, Eastvale will add another 995 houses. To compound the problem, the loss of the vehicle license fees has eliminated a key source of revenue for the city. At the moment, housing developers are responsible for their portion of the road construction as they develop a parcel of land. However, the impact of the added residences obviously extends far beyond the small stretch of road that they develop. At a minimum, I would propose substantially raising the various permit fees associated with the construction of new residences to account for their pro rata share of the costs for traffic mitigation measures involving road construction throughout Eastvale and for a fund for eminent domain actions. Measures such as this will need to be taken so that current and future residents can have the quality of life presently enjoyed by those of us in Eastvale.

I am sure they know me by name by now. Every time I call, they are probably saying to themselves "oh no not him again" or maybe not. Anyway, for the most part everyone has been helpful and understanding. The traffic around these schools has gotten a whole lot better thanks to everyone communicating and working together.

I feel that the City's top priority should be helping to make our city the safest and most desirable city to live in not only Southern California but the Nation. The City cannot accomplish this alone, it needs every ones help. I think we need more direct community involvement. Whether this be done by creating community advisory committees or expanding our current Neighborhood Watch Program. Another area the City needs to get more involved with is the "Shop Eastvale" campaign. It seems as though it is not being promoted to its potential. I think the Chamber of Commerce is in charge now but I am not sure if this is one of their top priorities. I know, for example, they promote "us" shopping at Lowes instead of Home Depot. Home Depot is in the City of Eastvale and we benefit directly from the tax revenue created.
