8.1 Proposed Regulations for Electronic Message Signs to be placed at Schools, Parks, and other Locations

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: The Planning Commission recommended that the City Council approve the first reading of an ordinance amending the sign regulations of the Eastvale zoning code to allow electronic message board signs at schools, parks, and other locations, entitled:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EASTVALE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING FINDINGS AND AMENDING THE SIGN REGULATIONS OF THE EASTVALE ZONING CODE, ADDING A NEW CATEGORY OF SIGNS: ELECTRONIC MESSAGE BOARD SIGNS AT PUBLIC SCHOOLS, PUBLIC PARKS, AND OTHER LOCATIONS
