Description: The proposed project involves the development of a 277,636-square-foot

warehouse building on a 15.8-acre site. The proposed project includes the

following

 A General Plan Amendment from General Commercial Retail (CR) to Light Industrial (LI) for the entire project site consisting of two parcels totaling 15.8 acres; and

 A Change of Zone from Scenic Highway Commercial (C-P-S) to Manufacturing Medium (M-M) for the northern parcel of approximately 12.5 acres (resulting in the entire site being zoned MM); and

A Major Development Review for the development of an approximately 273,636-square foot warehouse building and associated site improvements.

The City of Eastvale intends to adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for the project described above. An Initial Study (IS) was completed in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Based upon the information contained in the IS and pursuant to the requirements of CEQA, it has been determined that this project as proposed, revised, or mitigated will not have a significant impact on the environment. The approval of the project would incorporate a combination of project design features, standard conditions and requirements, and specific mitigation measures that would reduce any potential impacts to the environment to a less than significant level.
